Lincoln Phillips-Ibodrola

The agreement allowing Ibodrola's use of the Heller, Lyon and Carlson roads is being worked on by Attorney Snyder and Ibodrola's attorney. (the County's and Fairfield/Norway's contracts weren't applicable for Manheim) Mr. Phillips said that they have hired a company to check and video the roads before they will be used, no dump trucks or cement trucks will be allowed on these roads. We can expect afternoon deliveries and he will provide us with a schedule. The schedule will be put in the Times, and Carl will hand deliver copies to all residents along the route. Each flatbed carrying the blades will have escort vehicles that will be responsible for traffic control at the intersections. If there is any report of damage to our roads, Ibodrola will repair them. Attorney Snyder will have the completed agreement ready for the May 25th board meeting.

Superintendent's Report

The new truck should be delivered to Utica Mack this week.

If the weather is good next week, the roof should be done. The work should only take 2-3 days.

The highway men have been working on the entrances to the Snells Bush Cemetery.

Carl plans to move the barrier further down on River Road. More of the road is falling into the canal.
